Scholarship applications are available at the Lodi HS CRC. The Booster Club's scholarship committee tabulates the responses provided and the four recipients will be contacted by mail no later than July 15th. A formal announcement is made at the Fall Sports Kick-off off in September of the following school year.

<u>Requirements</u>: In order to be considered for this scholarship, the applicant must have been an active, paid member of the FFA for a minimum of one year.

- > Has at least one parent who is currently an alumni member.
- >Entering an agricultural related school.
- >Must have a GPA of 2.5

(Use their own application. One letter of recommendation needed.)

Lodi Music Boosters

<u>Requirements:</u> The recipient of this scholarship must be a Lodi High School graduate and plan on attending a post-secondary college. Recipient must also be

The purpose of the Laude System is to recognize students for the rigor of their academic program as well as their success in that program. This award system will be initiated with the class of 2018.

Award Levels

There are three levels of awards

- · Summa Cum Laude
- Magna Cum Laude
- · Cum Laude

Laude Score

A student's Laude Score will be determined by multiplying 1) the student's cumulative GPA after first semester senior year by 2) the number of recognized Cum Laude Recognition courses completed in all four years.
